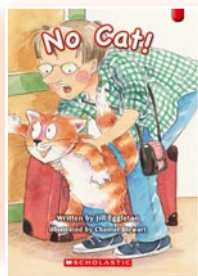

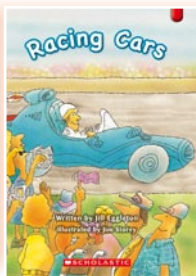
Key Links Red titles - 12 fiction & 12 nonfiction



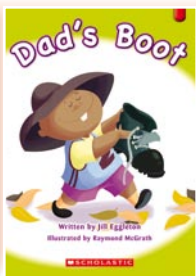
