

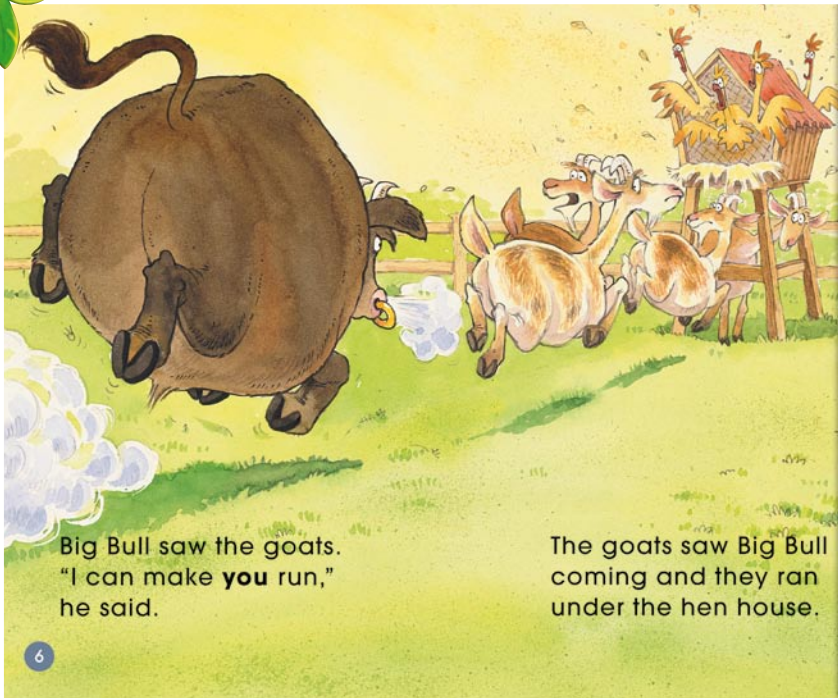
Yellow - Early

Sample Targets

PREVIEW
What is Big Bull doing now?
How do you know the goats are frightened? Where are they running? What do you think might happen next?

VIEW

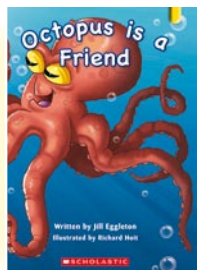

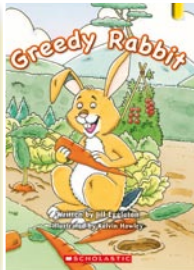

Key Links Yellow titles - 12 fiction & 12 nonfiction

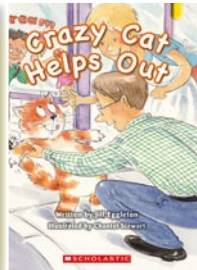
